


# Gyanodaya dedicates a day for the apostle of truth — Mahatma Gandhi and Lal Bahadur Shastri

All the students were assigned to their respective duties and sent for the obstacles activities level-1 in third area. Activities were:

Ladder bridge, Swinging beard, Tyre walking, Tunnel crossing, Russian wall, Log and tyre Bridge, High ladder climbing, Monkey Bridge, Tyre Bridge, Chimney climbing, Tyre tunnel

And the most thrilling activity was "Commando Bridge". We showed bravery by proving ourselves best in every activities. The high altitude and joyful view of Pachmarhi invited us to view the golden setting Sun and to bid it. 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


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
