The entire school community is divided into four houses: Lakshmi, Sarojini, Tagore and Vivekanand.



# ADMISSION PROCEDURE

## STEPS FOR ADMISSION -

1. Registration form can be collected from the account section on payment of Rs. 200 (Non refundable and non transferable)
2. For Nursery class, Parents are informed the date of personal interaction through phone/sms.
3. Written test is conducted for classes I and other upper classes.
4. Results are sent through sms / e-mail / phone.
5. Admission fee and 1st installment of tuition fee is to be paid within 3 days after receiving the message.
6. Admission of a child is confirmed only after payment of admission fees and submission of all required documents.

# DOCUMENTS REQUIRED

## DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED AT THE TIME OF ADMISSION

1. Original Birth Certificate, issued by the Registrar / Municipal Corporation (For Pre-Primary and Grade -I)
2. SAMAGRA ID (Photocopy)
3. Two recent passport size coloured photograph of the candidate.
4. One passport size coloured photograph of family members (Mother, Father, Real sibling)
5. Transfer/School leaving certificate from the previous school for Grade II and other higher classes.
6. Report card of the last school
7. Caste Certificate (If applicable).
8. Residence Proof (Photocopy).
9. Migration Certificate, if state/ board is changed.
10. Blood Group
11. Family Photo
12. Aadhar Card (Student and Parents)
13. Students' Permanent Education Number (PEN) and Aaar ID

Note: Student offered admission must complete the formalities within three working days after confirmation of admission otherwise the admission will stand cancelled and the seat will be passed on to the next student in the waiting list.

# FEE REFUND POLICY

## NON-REFUNDABLE FEES

- (a) Amount paid for Application Form and Prospectus is non-refundable and non transferable.
- (b) Registration fee is non-refundable and non transferable.

If student withdraws admission. Fees, would be refunded according to the policy.

# DUE DATES OF FEE INSTALLMENT

Note: The first installment fee should be paid along with the admission fee for new admissions.



## छात्रावास के नियम एवं निर्देश

1. छात्रावास में केवल 18 वर्ष से कम आयु के अविवाहित छात्र ही प्रवेश प्राप्त कर सकेंगे, जो एस.पी. जैन गुरुकुल उच्च माध्यमिक विद्यालय अथवा ज्ञानोदय एस.एम.व्ही. हायर सेकेंडरी स्कूल में कक्षा 6वीं से 12वीं (10+2) तक अध्ययनरत हों।
2. छात्र को छात्रावास में प्रवेश हेतु प्रवेश परीक्षा देना अनिवार्य होगा। परीक्षा में उत्तीर्ण छात्रों को रिक्त स्थानों पर वरीयता क्रम से प्रवेश प्रदान किया जाएगा। प्रवेश के समय छात्र को उत्तीर्ण कक्षा की अंकसूची की मूल प्रति प्रस्तुत करना अनिवार्य है।
3. छात्र का प्रवेश प्रारंभ में अस्थायी रहेगा। छात्र के अनुशासित एवं लगनशील पाए जाने पर ही उसे स्थायी प्रवेश दिया जाएगा।
4. कोई भी छात्र अपने पास नकद राशि या मूल्यवान वस्तुएँ नहीं रखेगा। इन्हें कार्यालय में जमा करना अनिवार्य होगा। गुम होने की स्थिति में संस्था जिम्मेदार नहीं होगी।
5. छात्रावास में अभक्ष्य वस्तुओं का सेवन, रात्रि में बाहर भोजन करना, मादक पदार्थों का सेवन, सिनेमा जाना, ताश खेलना तथा मोबाइल फोन, चूड़ा, गले की चेन आदि रखना पूर्णतः निषिद्ध है। छात्र के पास मोबाइल या कोई मनोरंजन उपकरण पाए जाने पर उसे जब्त कर लिया जाएगा।
6. छात्रावास में रहने वाले छात्रों को प्रतिदिन अनिवार्य रूप से धार्मिक शिक्षा ग्रहण करनी होगी। तिमाही एवं अर्धवार्षिक परीक्षा में अनुत्तीर्ण होने पर छात्र पर अर्थदण्ड लगाया जाएगा।
7. कोई भी छात्र बिना अनुमति संस्था परिसर से बाहर नहीं जा सकेगा। बिना अनुमति के बाहर जाने या भागने की स्थिति में संस्था की कोई जिम्मेदारी नहीं होगी।
8. फीस या आवश्यक सामग्री लाने हेतु छात्र को घर जाने की छुट्टी नहीं दी जाएगी। इसकी व्यवस्था अभिभावक स्वयं करेंगे। छात्र केवल संस्था द्वारा निर्धारित अवकाश में ही घर जा सकेगा।
9. प्रवेश के समय छात्र को संलग्न सूची में दर्शाए गए सभी आवश्यक सामान साथ लाना अनिवार्य होगा।
10. छात्र के पास केवल स्कूल एवं छात्रावास की निर्धारित यूनिफॉर्म ही रहेगी। अन्य वस्त्र पाए जाने पर उन्हें जब्त कर लिया जाएगा।
11. छात्रों को केवल निर्धारित दिवस एवं समय पर ही फोन करने एवं सुनने की सुविधा दी जाएगी। इसके अतिरिक्त किसी भी प्रकार की फोन सुविधा नहीं होगी।
12. छात्रों से मिलने का समय माह के प्रथम एवं तृतीय रविवार को दोपहर 1:00 बजे से 5:00 बजे तक निर्धारित है।
13. छात्र के प्रवेश के समय अभिभावक को संस्था की व्यवस्था का प्रत्यक्ष निरीक्षण कर संतुष्टि के उपरांत ही प्रवेश कराना चाहिए।
14. वर्ष में दो बार (सितम्बर एवं फरवरी माह में) अभिभावक छात्र की शैक्षणिक एवं अन्य गतिविधियों की जानकारी प्राप्त करें।
15. छात्र अपने सामान की सुरक्षा हेतु स्वयं जिम्मेदार रहेगा।
16. छात्र द्वारा छात्रावास की संपत्ति (फर्नीचर, विद्युत उपकरण आदि) को क्षति पहुँचाने पर क्षतिपूर्ति छात्र को आर्थिक दण्ड के रूप में जमा करनी होगी।
17. सभी छात्रों को छात्रावास की निर्धारित दिनचर्या का पालन अनिवार्य रूप से करना होगा।
18. कोई भी छात्र किसी अन्य छात्र के धर्म/जाति के आधार पर भेदभाव नहीं करेगा। उल्लंघन की स्थिति में अनुशासनात्मक कार्यवाही की जाएगी।
19. छात्रावास में किसी प्रकार का हथियार जैसे लाठी, चैन, चाकू आदि रखना पूर्णतः प्रतिबंधित है।
20. छात्रावास में किसी भी प्रकार की रैगिंग पूर्णतः प्रतिबंधित है।
21. छात्र को केवल स्वीकृत अवकाश पर ही घर जाने की अनुमति दी जाएगी। सगे भाई/बहन/बुआ/मामा के विवाह में 2 दिन का अवकाश दिया जाएगा। अन्य धार्मिक/सामाजिक कार्यक्रमों हेतु अवकाश स्वीकृत नहीं किया जाएगा।

यदि छात्र बिना सूचना के छुट्टी से विलंब से लौटता है तो उसे ₹500/- प्रतिदिन की दर से आर्थिक दण्ड जमा करना होगा।
